	It has been very many years since we last visited our inter Club financial		
	arrangements and the overall total of our finances has become very lopsided.		
	• It was all ok in the past but as we now have one side of the Club accounting for		
	80% of the usage of our facilities the existing custom of transferring equal		
	amounts from both sections to cover costs for maintenance, repairs etc has now		
	become quite antiquated and as our facilities are aging, we do need to establish a		
	real pool of funds to cover these expenses.

	• All nominees would also be recognised at the presentation night.
	• The award will be backed by a Volunteer Management Plan which includes
	ongoing support for volunteers through regular recognition activities, orientation, training and development opportunities.

Item	 Topic In the current Rules of Association for Cairns City Kennel Club, Rules 39 and 40 refer to election of the members of the Management Committee. Rule 39: The Officer Bearers and other Members of the Management Committee shall be elected annually at the Annual General Meeting and shall take office immediately upon election. Rule 40: Nominations of members proposed as Office Bearers or as other members of the Management Committee shall be signed by at least one member and the nominee. Nowhere does it mention that these persons shall hold a specific office to be 'other members' The CCKC Rules of Association, Rule 23 states defined the Officer Bearers as: President Secretary Treasurer Senior Vice-President Junior Vice-President And other such other officers as required There is no definition of "other members" or "other officers" or in the CCKC Rules of Association, Rule 26 states: There shall be a Management Committee consisting of the officer bearers and not less than four nor more than
	six members all of whom shall be elected at the Annual General Meeting or as provided by the Rules.
