

Conformation End of Year Trophy Rules

All conformation dog trophies:

- The dog must be owned or co-owned by a financial member of the Cains City Kennel Club Inc (CCKC) at the time of conformation show. NB: New membership is only considered valid once membership is accepted at a club meeting.
- Points are only accrued at the six conformations shows organised and run by the Cairns City Kennel Club. Three shows over the May long weekend shows, and three shows held in July.
- Points are allocated to the highest achievement for the show.
- Points do not accumulate.
- Does not include sweepstakes.
- Trophies for Baby Puppy, Groups, Top Conformation Dog, Neuter Dog are calculated by Dog Show Sub-Committee the using the marked catalogues from the CCKC conformation shows.
- Junior handler trophies are calculated by Dog Show Sub-Committee the using the results from junior handler competitions at the CCKC shows.
- CCKC members are required to submit results Conformation Championship Title and Best in Show awards.

Baby Puppy of the Year

- Baby Puppy Class (1/1a) only
- Points allocated:
 - Baby Puppy of Breed 5 points
 - Baby Puppy in Group 10 points
 - Baby Puppy in Show 15 points
- Example: Cairns Baby Wins A lot
 - Show 1: Baby of Breed and Baby in Group total 10 points
 - Show 2: Baby of Breed only total 5 points
 - Show 3: Baby of Breed, Baby in Group, Baby in Show 15 points
 - Show 4: Baby of Breed only total 5 points
 - Show 5: Baby of Breed and Baby in Group total 10 points
 - Show 6: Baby of Breed and Baby in Group total 10 points
 - Total points: 55

Groups 1 – 7 Dog of the year (Toy, Terrier, Gundog, Hound, Working, Utility, Non-Sporting)

- 1 trophy for each group
- All ordinary classes are eligible except Baby Puppy (1/1a) and Neuter (15/15a, 16/16a, 17/17a, 18/18a)
- Points allocated:
 - Dog or Bitch Challenge 5 points
 - \circ Best of Breed 10 points
 - Class in Group 15 points
 - Runner Up in Group 20 points
 - Best in Group 25 points

- Class in Show 30 points
- Runner up Best Exhibit in Show 35 points
- Best Exhibit in Show 40 points
- Example: Cains Dog Wins Even More
 - Show 1: Dog challenge and Aus Bred in Group 15 points
 - Show 2: Reserve dog challenge only 0 points
 - Show 3: Dog Challenge, Best of Breed, Aus Bred in Group, Aus Bred in Show 30 points
 - \circ Show 4: Dog Challenge, Best of Breed and Aus Bred in Group 15 points
 - Show 5: Dog Challenge, Best of Breed 10 points
 - Show 6: Dog Challenge, Best of Breed 10 points
 - o Total points: 80 points

Top Conformation Dog

- The highest point winner from the Groups 1 7 winners
- If there is a tie, then the dog with the highest number of awards will be considered the winner. The order of preference is as follows:
 - o Best Exhibit in Show
 - Runner up Best Exhibit in Show
 - o Class in Show
 - Best in Group
 - Runner Up in Group
 - o Class in Group
 - o Best of Breed
 - Dog or Bitch Challenge

Neuter Dog of The Year

- All neuter classes (15/15a, 16/16a, 17/17a, 18/18a)
- Points allocated:
 - Neuter Certificate 5 points
 - Best Neuter of Breed 10 points
 - Runner Up Neuter in Group 15 points
 - Best Neuter in Group 20 points
 - Runner up Best Neuter in Show 25 points
 - Best Neuter in Show 30 points
- Example: Cairns Dog Without Bits
 - Show 1: Neuter Certificate, Best Neuter of Breed, Runner up Neuter in Group 15 points
 - Show 2: Neuter Certificate 5 points
 - o Show 3: Neuter Certificate, Best Neuter of Breed, Best Neuter in Group 15 points
 - Show 4: Neuter Certificate, Best Neuter of Breed, Best Neuter in Group 15 points
 - $\circ~$ Show 5: Neuter Certificate, Best Neuter of Breed, Best Neuter in Group, Runner Up Best Neuter in Show 25 points
 - Show 6: Neuter Certificate, Best Neuter of Breed, Best Neuter in Group 15 points
 - Total points: 90 points

Conformation Championship Title and Best in Show Awards

- Ribbon or Rosette
- The dog must be owned or co-owned by a member of the CCKC at the time the title being awarded or best in show award was given.

- For a dog that has been awarded the following titles:
 - Australian Champion
 - o Grand Champion
 - Supreme Champion
 - Neuter Champion
 - Neuter Grand Champion
- For a dog that has won a best in show award won anywhere in Queensland
 - o Best Exhibit in Show
 - o Best Neuter in Show

Junior Handlers

- The junior handler must be a member of the Cairns City Kennel Club at the time of the time of the junior handler competition. NB: New membership is only considered valid once membership is accepted at a club meeting.
- Points are only accrued at junior handler competitions organised and run by the Cairns City Kennel Club at the shows over the May long weekend and shows held in July.
- A trophy for each age group is available:
 - 7 years to under 10 years
 - 10 years to under 13 years
 - 13 years to under 19 years
- Points are allocated to the highest achievement the competition.
- Points do not accumulate.
- Points allocated:
 - First place 3 points
 - \circ Second place 2 points
 - Third place 1 point
- Example, Sally-Sue
 - Competition 1: first place 3 points
 - Competition 2: second place 2 points
 - o Total points: 5
